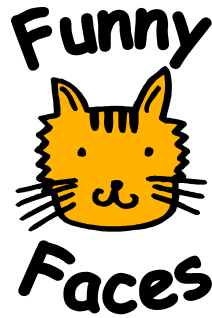

Health and Safety Terms and Conditions–Workshops, Events & Parties

Funny Faces takes Health and Safety issues very seriously and as such requires that all our services and activities are delivered in a safe environment, by skilled and experienced staff, using professional methods and products. In this way both our staff and clients will be able to enjoy the activities to the maximum, and risk of accidents and/or injury, and damage will be minimised.

1.Products and Equipment

Funny Faces uses only professional products and equipment that comply to EU regulations. We select products, materials, props and equipment, individually for each event or workshop, and always ensure that they are:-

- age and ability appropriate
- appropriate for the activity
- child friendly
- non toxic
- for art/craft activities - easy to remove (although for older children and adult workshops it may be necessary to use acrylic paints etc, and in this case advice will be given as to appropriate clothing/skin protection)
- recycle-able wherever possible
- selected to stimulate creativity and imagination
- selected to maximise enjoyment for all those participating in the event or workshop

2.Staff

Funny Faces is run by Delia Webb Bsc (Hons), C&G Level III Education and Childcare, who has over twenty years experience of working within the fields of education, the arts, and community development. Her drama, theatrical make up, and face painting skills have spanned 25 years, during which time she has worked with theatre/drama/festival groups in Liverpool, Wirral, Manchester, Wigan, and Cornwall. She is fully covered by public liability insurance, and an enhanced Criminal Records Bureau disclosure. In addition she is a qualified First Aider, and has level 2, and 3 qualifications in Health and Safety from the Chartered Institute of Environmental Health.

3.Methods

Funny Faces expects the event or party organiser to provide a safe environment in which to work. For outdoor events, the organisers must provide safe, and acceptable shelter and/or protection from the elements (wind, rain, direct sun etc). We will make every effort to maintain our own equipment, and working area safe and hazard free at all times, but will not be held liable or responsible for any accidents or damage caused by others attending the venue or event (a Risk Assessment for the activity is available to all event and party organisers on request). We will deliver art, craft, drama, and/or party activities as per our quotation for the event for the agreed numbers of participants. At no time will we be responsible for overall supervision of children, young people, or adults attending the venue/event/party, and organisers must therefore arrange an adequate number of responsible adults to be present to ensure appropriate levels of supervision. Organisers must ensure access to fresh cold water, and toilet facilities.

- At public events/venues no **unaccompanied** child under the age of 8 years can take part in any activity (But see below for private parties). Children under the age of 8 years may take part in activities if agreed by Funny Faces staff and accompanied at all times by a responsible adult (parent/guardian/carer) who has given relevant consent.
- For workshops and activities taking place at public events/venues, unaccompanied children and young people aged between 8 – 16 years may only participate in activities if a written consent form is signed and given to Funny Faces staff before commencement of activity.
- Without prejudice we reserve the right to refuse permission to take part in an activity, any child displaying signs of infection, illness, or other condition that may present a risk to themselves or others taking part in the activity.
- We will not force, or persuade, any child or young person to participate in any activity, or aspect of the activity, if they do not wish to do so.
- In the case of private parties, it remains the responsibility of the party organiser to ensure that all children and young people attending the party have permission to take part in the planned activities. It is also the responsibility of the party organiser to make Funny Faces aware (at least 48 hours before the party) of any child whose specific individual needs may necessitate fundamental adaptation to the planned activities in order to ensure they can participate.
- It is the responsibility of the event or party organiser to ensure the overall safety of the venue (indoor or outdoor) i.e that it complies with all current legislation with regards to Health and Safety, Fire Regulations, and the Disability Discrimination Act.
- We will give age appropriate instructions, and model safe techniques and methods to all participants.
- We will not be held liable or responsible for any accident, injury or damage caused by unsafe behaviour, or inappropriate use of products, materials, or equipment by any individual.
- We aim to be as inclusive as possible whilst maintaining the safety of each person taking part in the activities, our staff, and all others in the area. Wherever possible we will adapt materials and methods to suit an individual's needs, and/or offer alternative activities to ensure meaningful participation.
- We will maintain a professional attitude at all times, and ensure we always remain sensitive to each person's individual needs.
